

Under Chiba University's Leading Research Promotion Program "Chiba Studies on Global Fair Society (New Frontiers of Studies on Fair Society Values and Public Vision in the age after COVID 19)", we will hold an international seminar (online) in the emerging research field "Positive Political Psychology", a new area of research (which has been internationally propounded by Professor Masaya Kobayashi. He will give a lecture on "Wellness, Fairness, and Worthiness: Psychosocial Foundations for the Common Good."

Professor Akito Shimizu (Shonan Fujisawa Campus (SFC), Keio University, Japan), who is well-known for his research into "Work Engagement", will serve as a discussant, and we will also invite related comments from the members of this research project.
